1. Dance competition will be conducted under SOBHD regulations
2. First to enter Last to Dance rule applies
3. Highland and National points will be combined to determine aggregate trophy winner
4. Decision of the judge is final
5. All age groups will be determined at the close of the entry
6. All groups will receive medals and cash prizes will be awarded to premier dancers
8. An Aggregate trophy will be awarded in each class, except primary as long as there are at least three dancers in the age group. A special perpetual trophy and prize money will be awarded in memory of Kathleen McMaster by her family for the Premier Village Maid
9. 2020 Scot Dance card is required to compete.
10. Advance registration is necessary. Dancers must enter on line by May 20, 2020. No exceptions.
11. No refunds will be given for entry fees
12. Any protest must be submitted in writing to the competition organizer, properly signed and accompanied by a fee of \$20. It must be made immediately following the competition. If the protest is sustained the fee will be returned.
